The School will, this September, comprise of approximately 600 students with d'Overbroeck's International School educating c80 students, all of whom come from overseas and board. In 2017, The International School moved into a new building which offers both space and improved facilities, including laboratories and an art room. The school is committed to making further improvements in the resources it provides.

The International School educates students aged 14-17, who can opt, depending on their age, for a one or two-year IGCSE programme. Following IGCSEs, 80% students join the d'Overbroeck's Sixth Form where they sit A-Levels following a two-year course.

d'Overbroecks is now looking to appoint a new Head of its large and expanding International School. This is a key senior management position, involving strategic and academic leadership in the school and offering an opportunity to lead d'Overbroeck's International, with a target of doubling total enrolment over the next 2 to 3 years, while maintaining its standards of excellence.
